MARTIAL ARTS ACADEMY Thursdays | 6:30-7:30pm | The Attic

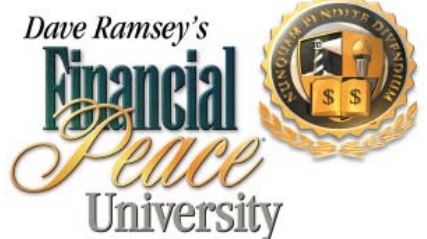
